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**Título: Territórios, Territorialidades e Fronteiras (séculos XVI – XX)**

**Ementa:** A disciplina propõe discutir uma bibliografia sobre as questões de território, territorialidades e fronteiras entre os séculos XVI e XX. O foco será em estudos mais recentes da história europeia e sul-americana, serão discutidos também alguns textos clássicos que tratam da metodologia e teoria da historiografia. A formação de fronteiras 1) como limites entre territórios e Estados, 2) como zonas de contato, 3) como espaços a serem superados e explorados, será discutida com base em diferentes abordagens micro- e macro-históricas, que tratam desse tema do ponto de vista das histórias política, social, cultural, ambiental, do direito e das ciências.

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
